GNX #125 – A DREAM COMES TRUE

In 1984 I was 43, we had been living in Manhattan for 10 years after moving there for Macy's from San Francisco. When Buick built the first "Black Cars" for 1985, I fell in love with the stealth look and the significant performance attributed to the Grand National and its turbo-charged V-6. I admit to an addiction to Buick V-8's and the Straight 8's before them, but the GN was power and speed technology that I lusted after. However, living in Manhattan pretty much voided my lust and time marched on . . .

Then, for the last production year of the GN in 1987, Buick created a special, high performance version modified by ASC/McLaren to be a "Corvette Killer". The GNX was "unobtainium" at the time. 547 were built because that was the number of key dealers that Buick wished to have in their showrooms. The MSRP was \$10,995 over the GN's selling price of about \$18,500 and many of the cars were sold on a "What is your bid?" basis. Again, I lusted for this car but knew I wasn't going to own a GNX. Time marched on . . .

30 years go by and it's 2017. A terrible year as I lost my life's love, Karen, to Lupus in July.

In September Hemmings had an ad for a 78,000 mile, unmolested, two owner, original 1987 GNX - #125 for sale. Now there are two kinds of GNX's in existence. There are the ones that were raced, modified and beat to death and there are the ones that were put away to become no mileage or low mileage, mid-six-figure collectable cars. "Drivers" are rarer than a Jamaican snowboarder! "Buicks are meant to be driven" rings in my head and opportunity knocks.

I called the owner, told him I would come to Florida to see him and the car in early October. I arranged a flight to Orlando, a car service to his house and bought his GNX on the spot. It felt GOOD! I hadn't felt that way since long before July 10, 2017. It was my 76th birthday present.

I had arranged to take the Amtrak Auto Train from Sanford, Florida to Lorton, Virginia (just south of D.C.) and then drive "Rowdy" 355 miles home to Grahamsville, New York to meet the rest of the gang . . .


If you are interested in serving, please contact one of the current directors. Nominations can also be made from the floor during the Annual Meeting.


